## A short history

Formed by just four enthusiasts in 1968, the Club was first called the “Pre-49 Car Club”, and then renamed the Devon Vintage Car Club in 1970. The Club now has some 240 members and is a member of the Federation of British Historical Motor Clubs

## The club’s aims

Our main objective is to bring together those whose interest in the preserving, restoring and using of “classic” vehicles.

To this end various events are organized during the year, the most well-known is possibly the Spring and October Autojumbles. Club runs are very popular throughout the year and they usually include lunch or teas. We also occasionally meet up with other like-minded clubs. Some members have time to time organized short holidays and trips abroad. We also hold regular breakfast meetings through much of the year.

The Club produces a monthly magazine. This includes a calendar of club events, articles written by Club members, all the

latest FBHVC news and contacts for other events in and around Devon. Club members can advertise for free the sale of their car or car related items. The magazine is available by post and e-mail. It is not necessary for you to own or be running a classic vehicle to partake in most of our events. Your enthusiastic support of our aims is all that is needed.
